

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Milton Weill, a citizen of the United States and a resident of the city, county, and State of New York, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Jewelry Box, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof:

Fig. 1 is a top plan view of a jewelry box show-

ing my new design;

Fig. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

Fig. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;

Fig. 4 is a view like Fig. 3 with the cover open; and

Fig. 5 is a section on line **5—5** of Fig. 2.
